Full Charge

Services cannot be denied based upon income or the inability to pay

Key:

1. Charges are based on a cost analysis.
2. Per Title X requirements, a schedule of discounts (SOD) for charges is used for family incomes between 101% - 250% FPL.
3. Charges to client with incomes **above 250% FPL** must be made in accordance with a schedule of fees designed to recover the reasonable cost of providing services (see JSI Cost Analysis Part II).
4. The schedule must be proportional through all levels.
5. Same scale must be applied to labs, medications and supplies.
6. Decimals round upward on chart.
