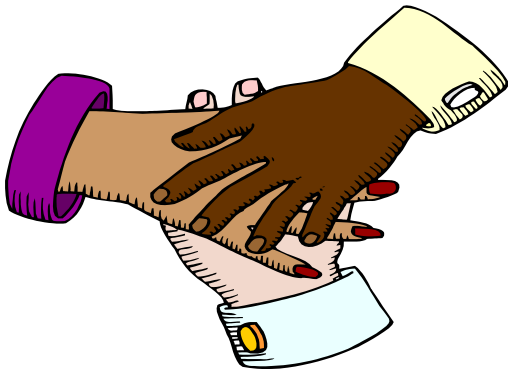




What is TRI-CAP?

A fifteen member Board of Directors represents low-income clients, the private sector, and public officials oversee TRI-CAP. Policy and advisory councils made up of local volunteers guide the programs offered by TRI-CAP.
